NYS Health Requirements

Immunizations

According to NYS Education Law, all new entrants K-12 are to be immunized per NYS regulations. ***Students are not permitted to attend school for more than 14 calendar days without documentation of the immunizations required by Public Health Law. Students not in compliance with NYS Immunization requirements will be excluded from school within the 14 days. The 14 days may be extended to 30 days for a student from out of state or another country if good faith effort is shown to comply.*** Parents are responsible for submitting a copy of their child's immunization record to the school office. Students can receive immunizations through their providers or their local Health Department. The NYS Immunization Requirements can be found here:

Physical Examinations

Education Law also requires physical examinations of students when they:

- Enter the district for the first time
- Are in Grades K, 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 and 11
- Participate in interscholastic sports
- Need working papers
- Are referred by/to the Committee on Special Education

Parents are responsible for submitting a copy of their child's physical to the school office. School physical examinations for school must be documented on the NYS Required Health Examination Form found here:
