1. Return your completed International Student Application along with the following documents:
 - a. Transcript of all school grades *translated in English by school official*
 - b. Academic Recommendation from school official *translated in English*
 - c. Certificate of Immunizations *translated in English*
 - d. Copy of Birth Certificate or Passport
 - e. Medical Healthy History Form
 - f. Health Examination Form (signed by physician)
 - g. Copy of student's medical insurance card

2. After receiving the application form and records, an RCCA Representative will conduct a phone interview with the student.

3. After Administrator approval and acceptance into RCCA, an I-20 Form (Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant (F-1) Student) will be issued.

VI. Statement of Belief

- E. RCCA teaches the universal depravity of man, and hence, the need of regeneration of the Holy Spirit.
- F. RCCA teaches that the salvation of sinners is wholly of grace on the single ground of faith in the shed blood of Jesus Christ our Lord, and that an eternal Son offers and eternal salvation through an eternal Spirit.
